


# B-SAFE® 35 / B-SAFE® 35 ELITE




Britax has received reports that the center tab can break in certain B-Safe infant car seats, potentially causing a choking hazard.

Before changing the chest clip, confirm that it needs to be replaced by following these steps.

- **1.** Open chest clip. Press tab and pull the two sides of the chest clip apart (Fig. 1).
- 2. Turn chest clip over (Fig. 2).
- **3.** If the back of your chest clip reads ABS, your chest clip must be replaced (Fig. 3). Follow the instructions attached for replacement.

### **Chest Clip Kit:**

- Chest Clip Assembly
- No Tools Required

### **Chest Clip Removal**

- 1. Loosen the harness by pressing the harness adjuster release button and pulling both harness straps forward (Fig. 1).
- 2. From the back of the seat, remove the harness straps from the harness yoke (Fig. 2).
- 3. Carefully pull both harness straps to the front of the seat (Fig. 3).
- 4. Remove the comfort pads from each of the harness straps (Fig. 4) and set aside for later replacement.
- 5. Remove the chest clip from the harness straps and discard (Fig. 5).

## **Chest Clip Removal**

- **1.** Route the harness straps through the new chest clip assembly.
- 2. Slide the comfort pads onto the harness straps.
- 3. Ensure that the harness straps are not twisted and route through the appropriate slots in the back of the seat (Fig. 6).
- 4. Secure the harness straps onto the harness yoke with the appropriate loops (Fig. 7 and 8).
  - Inner Loop: For infants weighing less than 11 lbs (5 kg).
  - Outer Loop: For infants weighing over 11 lbs (5 kg).
- 5. The installation is now complete and your infant car seat is ready to use.
